VERY PRIVATE AND PERSONAL

Your Holiness,

Grace and Peace to you in Jesus our Life in this Holy Season of Easter. I am writing you from jail. I am in jail for the sake of the innocent unborn. On Good Friday I left a long letter (28 pgs.) addressed to you with the secretary to the Commandant of the Swiss guards at the Porta St. Anna gate, at the Vatican. I was assured that this most important document would be delivered to you through the capable hands of the Secretary of State, Cardinal Bertone.

The said letter contained a cover letter addressed personally to you Holiness, which in one page described the contents of the entire document. The document is a letter that I have written and sent by email on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 11, to all 264 Bishops, Archbishops, and Cardinals in Canada and the United States.

The letter appeals to the conscience of each prelate to do what I am doing in order to fight the abominable holocaust of abortion and to bring an almost immediate end to public funded abortion. It asks each bishop to publicly declare that they will no longer file a personal income tax return until the laws are changed prohibiting tax funded abortion/murder.

Millions of faithful Catholics will follow courageous pastors who stand up, martyr-like, and risk civil punishment rather than co-operate with those who use their money to murder innocent unborn children, children who as you have said are the very poorest of the poor and are our most vulnerable brothers and sisters.

We must stand up Holiness; the time is long since past; soon Divine Justice will avenge this innocent blood. This is decidedly not an issue governed by platitudes or protocol of Church vs. State arguments. This is the most fundamental human right of all-the right to LIVE, the right to be born. If we stand and refuse to pay for these untold millions of murders in union with our priests and bishops and our Pope, the politicians will soon get the message-they will soon say to their people, "Abortion is still legal, the only thing is, if you want an abortion, you are going to have to pay for it yourself. This is the only just way in a democracy; millions believe abortion is murder and should not be compelled to pay for what they believe in good faith and

conscience is murder.” And that will reduce the abortions in Canada and the United States by more than 50% the very first year. All of our data indicates and confirms this. And this step, taken boldly, courageously for the little ones, will be the death knell for abortion itself.

During Holy Week, when in Rome with my dear friend retired Bishop J. Faber MacDonald, we attended, on April 1, the Holy Thursday Chrism Mass in St. Peter’s. Bishop Macdonald was delighted for the opportunity to concelebrate with you on such a holy day. On his last ad limina he told you that after 30 years, he had finally succeeded in ending the abuse of General Absolution, which began in Saint John under Bishop Arthur Gilbert, may God have mercy on his soul, so many years before. For this decision in which there was so much hard opposition from many “progressive” priests, the Bishop became a hero of mine. I assisted him in ending this abuse and we thus became allies in the Lord. He said that you told him that when you were the Ordinary in Munich, you also had to correct this abuse, finding many pastors were simply not following the guidelines of the three forms of confession in the Rite of the Sacrament of Penance. I believe monthly private confession, promoted, preached and practiced would heal the ugly massive wounds that scourge our Holy Catholic Church, wounds that grow ever larger because of grave sin especially among clergy.

In your beautiful homily on Holy Thursday you spoke about standing up against laws that kill innocent human life. I cannot access the exact quote here in jail, but I know when I read it after I came home, I added that paragraph from your homily before I sent the long letter document to all the bishops on Divine Mercy Sunday.

I was a personal friend from 1984 till death of Blessed Mother Teresa and the Venerable Pope John Paul II. I have fought for human life, the family, and chastity full time since 1981. I have personally opened several crisis pregnancy centers, educated many groups of people on abortion and contraception, protested in newspapers with articles and letters, written Prime Ministers, and Presidents on the evil of abortion, marched and protested peacefully in front of hospitals and “clinics” that perform abortions and it will only be known in Heaven what small effect I have had. I know one irrefutable fact however. When I started fighting abortion in 1981, there were 14 abortions for every 100 pregnancies in Canada. Now there are 32.

We as a people have fallen deathly asleep to the unspeakable atrocity of abortion/murder. And I am talking about the best of Catholics – Cardinals – Bishops, and priests. The lay people are God’s flock, His sheep. They will follow a real shepherd. Bless you for making Saint Jean Vianney the patron of this Year of the Priest, which ends in a month or so. This holy, humble man said:

“Whenever the priest is a saint, the people are very holy.
Whenever the priest is very good, the people are good.
Whenever the priest is good, the people are fair.
Whenever the priest is fair, the people are poor.

Whenever the priest is poor, the people are lost.”

Most Catholics are lost in the world of the West, in Europe and the Americas. This horror happened rapidly - just 50 years since 1960. We began “experimenting” with contraception pills, then unknown as abortifacients but always carnal, unchaste; now we have outright before and after intimacy – pills - murder medicine. And it, and other concoctions and methods are being used to euthanize the elderly and the unwanted increasingly as seen in the news.

We hold infallibly that human life is God’s supreme creation, made in His image and likeness endowed with the dignity of personhood from the instant of conception. We reverence life the more because God loved man so infinitely that He became man, that man may become like God.

Yet we do not respect the unborn in practice. The gap between infallible teaching and actual practice grows every day largely because of a real demonic silence in homilies. TV entertainment the world over, especially in the West propagandizes carnality, laughs at virginity, promotes co-habitation and divorce, smirks at masturbation and insists on contraception while the “NEWS” delivers bulletins constantly of new laws promoting same-sex “marriage”, euthanasia and embryonic stem-cell research and totally ignores pro-life supporters. The most powerful institution in the world, the Holy Roman Catholic Church is full of dis - ease. She chokes on feelings of disease when called to preach homilies about mortal sin, chastity, contraception, Satan, fornication, adultery and homosexual “marriage”. Abortion is rarely condemned as plain murder for fear of “offending” the murderers in the pew. The worst silence is absolutely deafening; never homilies about the absolute imperative of frequent personal confession, what is serious sin, Heaven, the narrow road, purgatory, the devil and demons, judgment, everlasting joy or everlasting damnation. The great teaching Church has utterly failed for two generations now -50 years- to teach her priests how to preach.

So Satan’s media preaches quietly, insinuatingly, malevolently and less than 20% of Catholics bother to go to Sunday Mass because the homilies are full of ease and uncontroversy, Masses are irreverent and 100% go to receive the Sacred Host aware of no sin whatever. Meanwhile, in Canada and the USA sixty million plus of our unborn brothers and sisters in the womb are viciously executed in what God intended to be the safest place in the universe, the female womb. All in just 40 years.

If 60 million born human beings were murdered how would we have reacted??
About 5,000 babies are murdered in the womb every day in Canada and the USA. If they were born babies – what an outrage!
Unborn babies - what a yawn.

Many people over the last 30 years have called me a prophet, priests in pulpits have said so, lay people have said I was the “conscience” of a diocese, others have used this uncomfortable description and my dear friend, Bishop MacDonald has asked me

more than once to “accept my prophetic character and calling”. I do not know whether I am or not a prophet. I do know I cannot remain quiet Holiness, even addressing your esteemed person as the Vicar of Christ.

I delivered a copy of my letter to all the Bishops of Canada and the U.S. to you on Good Friday. I asked you to respond by April 11 if you did not wish me to send it. I heard nothing.

Now Holiness, dear Santo Padre, I must say to you –

Speak out boldly and incessantly against laws promoting abortion – and call it what it is, plain murder of the most innocent.

Do this in public forums outside of liturgies as well during homilies.

CONDEMN TAX-FUNDED ABORTION OFTEN!

WRITE AN ENCYCLICAL for the entire Church and **ALL persons of good will demanding that **PUBLIC MONEY – INCOME TAX OR ANY TAXES NEVER BE USED FOR KILLING HUMAN BEINGS, whether the innocent unborn, the aged, the disabled, the handicapped or the unwanted.****

Encourage all citizens, lay or clergy to refuse to co-operate with governments by withholding tax returns in non-violent civil disobedience to laws that legalize murder.

This, dear Holiness is what you must do. For more than 30 years I have endeavoured to go to Holy Mass every day, and to spend one hour in Adoration daily before the Tabernacle after Mass asking for Jesus to help me put an end to this horrific evil of abortion. I do not claim to be a prophet. What I do claim is that I believe God is asking me to write this letter to you from jail and tell you plainly what I believe God wants **YOU TO DO.**

Because, the time of Mercy is **soon** at an end.
